UPDATE: State highways open as water levels recede

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is announcing that all but one of the state highways in southeastern Wisconsin affected by the flooding are open to motorists. WisDOT, along with corresponding counties, municipalities and other agencies, has made strides in assessing road conditions and monitoring water levels.

The remaining closure in place is at WIS 50 over the Fox River near the town of New Munster. The closure is anticipated to be in place throughout the weekend, or until water levels recede. It is suggested that motorists follow alternate routes along WIS 83, WIS 11 and WIS 75 to get around the closure.

Motorists are advised to drive with caution when traveling in impacted areas and are reminded to not drive through standing or flowing water.
