State highway closures in Crawford, Marquette, Sauk County

While most of the state highways impacted by last week's flooding in southwest Wisconsin have reopened, motorists should continue to use safety precautions and expect to encounter work crews assessing roadways and making repairs.

The following state highway locations remain **closed**.

Crawford County

WIS 131 at WIS 60 intersection
WIS 171, Gays Mills
WIS 171, east of Gays Mills

Marquette

WIS 23 at Neenah Creek just east of Briggsville; detour north on WIS 13, east on WIS 82, south on I-39

Sauk County

WIS 136 between WIS 33 and WIS 154, north of Rock Springs
WIS 136/WIS 154 Intersection, Rock Springs
